Course Description: The course is a 9.5-km loop, 1 km of which is hard-packed dirt road - now you can watch Paris-Roubaix in April and know what the pros are going through! The dirt road will make the field get into 2 - 3 lines (warning - there are some pot holes!). Although the dirt road is mostly flat, choosing your line will be important. There are no big rocks or gravel on the road, just a fine sand that is very hard packed. Each time around the 9.5 km loop you will also encounter smooth, flat road and two good hills. Come try a true spring classic, taste what the pros do!

Note: Promoter reserves the right to take dirt road out of the loop if weather conditions make the road impassable.

Pre-registration:

- mail current USCF Standard Athletes Entry form with a check (payable to Forest Acres Cycling Team) to Tom Sunday, 6012 Ashwood Road, Columbia, SC 29206. Mailed registration must be received by March 9, 2010.
- OR go to www.Pre-reg.com and register online. Online pre-registration ends March 11, 2010.

Day-of-event registration:

- Registration opens at 7:30 AM and closes 30 minutes prior to each category's start time.
- There is a \$5 fee for day-of-event registration.

Directions to Blythewood

From I - 77 North or South, take Exit 27 (Blythewood Road), proceed east until the road ends into Highway 21. Take a right on Highway 21 and then take a left at the first stop light. The Town Hall of Blythewood is on your left. Parking and registration for the road race takes place here.
